School and Community

Bayless School District, organized in 1868, is a small district located in South St. Louis County, immediately south of the St. Louis City limits. It is primarily residential. Our cost per pupil expenditure is \$8,936.73. 63% of our student population qualifies for free or reduced lunch. Bayless School District has about 1684 students enrolled in the district in the three buildings: Elementary (K-5), Junior High (6-8) and High School (9-12). Bayless High School has 469 students with 50% reporting English is not the first language, the majority of these languages include Bosnian, Vietnamese and Arabic.

Bayless High School was founded in 1932 and maintains a traditional 7 hour school day with a 30 minute advisory 2 days a week and academic lab 3 days a week.
