School and Community

Bayless School District, organized in 1868, is a small, primarily residential district located in South St. Louis County, immediately south of the St. Louis City limits. Our cost per pupil expenditure is \$9,506.33. 66% of our student population qualifies for free or reduced lunch. Bayless School District has about 1730 students enrolled in the district in the three buildings: Elementary (K-5), Junior High (6-8) and High School (9-12). Bayless High School has 513 students with 54% reporting English is not their first language, the majority of these languages include Bosnian, Vietnamese and Arabic.

Schedule

Bayless High School was founded in 1932 and maintains a traditional 7 hour school day with a 30 minute advisory 2 days a week and academic lab 3 days a week.
